Go to the school website. Click on Home Activities and scroll down to Online Books and click on CJ Fallon.

Click Primary, 1<sup>st</sup> Class, English. Click on My Read at Home and then click on the Eye icon beside the book.

Read pg. 109- The Bluebell Wood together with your child. Go through any difficult words and explain them.

Answer the 5 questions at the bottom of the page in your copy.

- Spellings

Choose a word from blocks 109 and 110 to put into a sentence into your copy.

## **Comhrá**

Oisín: Tá mé tinn. Tá pian i mo bholg.

Mamaí: An bhfuil tú te?

Mamaí: Tá tú an-te. Tá tú tinn.

Oisín: Tá pian i mo bholg.

Seán: Is mise an dochtúir.

Síofra: Is mise an t-altra.

Seán: Seo leigheas duit.

Mamaí: Seo leigheas duit, a Oisín.

Síofra: Tá Oisín tinn.

Seán: Oisín bocht!

(Test your acting skills and act out the story.)
