- ** Practise the Irish words and phrases from the list I gave you last week. It will give your child the opportunity to practise speaking Irish Daily. This list might be useful if you have difficulty logging onto the Folens website. You could also visit the Irish websites I had in my letter before Easter.
- ** I have include a Pizza cutting activity (at the end of the week's work) for you to do today. Last week you were reading instructions for how to make a pizza. Today you are going to put your favourite toppings on the pizza.
