Recycled Paper

STEAM Activity



Directions:

- 1. Assemble your wooden frame using eight craft sticks. Glue the eight craft sticks together using the hot glue gun to make a large square frame. Set the frame aside and allow it to dry completely before using.
- 2. Tear the egg carton into tiny pieces. It should yield 2-3 cups of torn cardboard pieces.
- 3. Place the torn cardboard pieces into the blender.
- 4. Boil two cups of water.
- 5. While the water is boiling, cut the mesh fabric in half. Next, glue half of the mesh fabric to the wooden frame and cut off any excess fabric.
- 6. Carefully pour the boiling water into the blender with the cardboard pieces.
- 7. Put the lid on the blender and blend the cardboard pieces and water together until a soup-like consistency is reached.
- 8. Place the wooden frame over a deep, square baking dish.
- 9. Next, slowly pour the pulp mixture from the blender onto the frame.
- 10. Place the second piece of mesh material over the pulp mixture and gently use a rolling pin to evenly spread the mixture across the wooden frame.
- 11. Allow all the water to drip from the paper and into the baking dish.
- 12. Dry the paper on the frame for 24 hours and then gently peel the mesh fabric away from both sides to reveal your recycled paper.

You will need:

- ½ yard of mesh fabric, cut into two equal sized pieces
- 8 wooden craft sticks
- Hot glue gun and glue sticks
- Scissors
- 1 cardboard egg carton
- Rolling pin
- Blender
- · Measuring cups
- Large, square baking dish
