When the reader appears in the box click on the eye symbol beside it.

Print off and cut up list of words (included at the end of this week's work.)

Fun at Home: Read pg.12 together and then ask your child to read it on their own.

<u>New words</u> (yoga,her,mat,So,does,puts) Find these words on the page and make sentences with the new words. If you have magnetic letters or playdough then you can make the new words with them. Discuss the picture and ask your child questions about this page.

If you have magnetic letters or playdough then you can make the new words with them. Make sentences with these words and see if you can find them in other books.

- Phonics: sound of the week <u>ch</u>. Go to youtube jollyphonics for <u>ch</u> song and activities to do
 Can you draw pictures of things beginning with <u>ch</u> and label them. Look for the letter blend <u>ch</u> in books.
- ** We have now finished all the initial letter sounds. Please go back over all the sounds in their scrapbook. Make fans with the letter cards at the back of their Sounds Good Phonics. Some of their earlier sound fans are at school.

Ask your child to show you the correct letter on the fan for different words e.g. what sound can you hear at the beginning of **dog**

- Rhyme of the week: log onto topmarks.co.uk. Type nursery rhymes into search.
 - Find Row, Row, Row your Boat and sing it with your child.
- Writing: Make sentences with the new words: puts, her, in your copy.
 - Don't forget to leave a space between each word.
- Practise Read to the Star sheets and rhyming word cards.
- Practise writing your name each day
- ** Extra work: If you have time you could write a sentence about something you did at the weekend. Write Monday above the sentence, and add a picture.

Maths

Ongoing Maths: Continue to do the number formation booklet I included if you haven't finished it
already. Practise counting with your child as often as possible. Practise Days of the week regularly.

This week your child will be doing money activities. It would be helpful if you gave them opportunities to use real money to make amounts to 10c. They could sort the different coins in your purse, do coin rubbings and even set up a shop where they can practise counting out the correct amount of money. If your child has older brothers or sisters they could help set up the shop and be involved in the shopping activities.
